

Thursday January 24	<b>Opening Day</b> Students and families may arrive after 2:00pm and meet the faculty in the Common Room at 4:30pm. Parents' Meeting from 5:00pm to 6:00pm.
January 26-27 February 2-3 February 9-10 March 2-3	<b>Closed Weekends</b> To support a strong start to our semester together, we require students to stay with the community and to sleep in the CITYterm dorm each night. The first night students may request a leave is Saturday, February 16 <sup>th</sup> .
Friday March 8	<b>Spring Vacation begins at 3:00pm</b> CITYterm will provide transportation to local airports. Flights should be scheduled no earlier than 5:30pm. The dorm will close at 5:00pm.
Sunday March 24	<b>Students return to CITYterm between 6:00pm and 9:00pm</b> Students should make their own transportation arrangements from local airports and train stations. Please note: All students must return for a community meeting on Sunday evening at 9:00pm.
Sunday April 21	<b>Neighborhood Study Kick-Off</b> This Sunday will function like a class day and will begin at 10:00am. Students who wish to take a weekend leave may do so on Friday night (after classes) or Saturday during the day. All students must be in the dorm Sunday before the Kick-Off.
Friday-Saturday April 26-27	<b>Neighborhood Study Presentations and Neighborhood Visits</b> Families and friends are invited to the Friday presentations (5:00pm) and Saturday neighborhood visits in NYC (10:00am-4:00pm).
Saturday-Monday April 27-April 29	<b>Extended Open Weekend</b> Students may leave CITYterm at 4:00pm on Saturday (after the neighborhood visits). The dorm will remain open all weekend. Traveling students must return to the dorm by 6:00pm on Monday night. Please note: All students must return for a community meeting on Monday evening at 6:00pm.
Saturday April 13	<b>ACT administered at Sleepy Hollow High School (optional)</b> Students are responsible for test registration and for communicating their intent to take the exam with the faculty.
Saturday May 4	<b>SAT administered at The Masters School or Dobbs Ferry High School (optional)</b> Students are responsible for test registration and for communicating their intent to take the exam with the faculty.

Friday May 24	<b>Closing Ceremony</b> Families and friends are invited to join us from 10:30am to 12:30pm. Flights should be scheduled for no earlier than 3:00pm. Dorm will close at 2:00pm.

**Closed Weekends** are designed to help us create our integrated life of living and learning together. On a closed weekend, we expect students to stay in the dorm on both Friday and Saturday nights and use their free time on Saturday evening and Sunday to explore New York City with their CITYterm friends. On a typical **Open Weekend**, students are allowed – assuming they have parental and faculty permission – to leave CITYterm after our Saturday afternoon programming and return to the dorm by dinner on Sunday.

Please note that CITYterm is a six day per week program. Therefore, **Saturday Classes and Expeditions** in the city are a **mandatory** part of the curriculum. Weekends begin after class on Saturday at 4:00pm. In order to preserve as many class days as possible, CITYterm asks that parents do not schedule travel that interferes with the class schedule. We ask that students register for the **SAT** at **The Masters School** (test center 33360) or **Dobbs Ferry High School** (test center 33358) on the **May 4** test date only. We also ask that students register for the **ACT** at **Sleepy Hollow High School** (test center 334220) on the **April 13** test date only.
